HR Alliance Compensation Survey & Trend Report

The HR Alliance DC Compensation Survey, now in its 35th year, can help you attract and retain the DC-metro area's top talent, while helping your organization continuously improve its compensation practices and talent management strategies.

In 2023, we compiled data on over 400 positions across over 75 job families covering over 62,000 incumbents in the Greater Washington, DC metro area.

Here is a sample of the findings:

- DC area turnover was slightly higher than the average for the entire US.
- The survey saw an increase in investment in Talent Acquisition, with over **55%** of organizations reporting it as their top area of investment for their Human Resources Departments.
- This year companies have reported that 46% of their employees are able to work remotely.
